### **Your confidentiality**

### **Use of the data**

National School Improvement Partnerships will report the results to the school in an aggregated format so that individuals cannot be identified. To enable drill-down reporting, the information provided to the school will contain data based on background information.

### **How to complete the survey**

You will be asked whether you are completing the survey for an individual child or as a family. If the experiences of your children are similar, then responding once will suffice. If, however, your children are experiencing very different learning environments then you might want to complete the survey more than once for different children.

The survey contains statements about practices which could take place at Emmaus. For each statement, you are asked to indicate how often the statement takes place. There are no 'right' or 'wrong' answers. Your opinion is what is wanted. Please be sure to answer all questions.

Some statements in may be fairly similar to other statements. Don't worry about this. Simply give your opinion about all statements.
