Responding to Risks of Harm Abuse and Neglect – Education and Care (RRHAN-EC)

As of 1st July, all existing volunteers at Emmaus Catholic School are required to complete the revised online training for responding to abuse and neglect in an education and care setting.

The revised course is now titled Responding to Risks of Harm Abuse and Neglect – Education and Care (RRHAN-EC) – formerly Responding to Abuse and Neglect Training – Education and Care (RAN-EC). This change of name reflects changes to legislation and the expanded content of the new course.


All existing volunteers at Emmaus are now required to complete this revised course, which is a 2 hour online course. This revised course must be completed by 31st December 2021 to be compliant as a volunteer at Emmaus Catholic School.

If you have recently undertaken Responding to Abuse and Neglect training, with a date of 2021 on your certification – you are not required to undertake the revised course.
